

Scholarship Committee Report

With the gifting of a substantial sum from the Stuart and Harriette Sacklow estate, long time members and friends of the Ohav family, the Scholarship Committee was able to alter the funding of camp scholarships for summer 2021 programs. In the past, each child was given the same general scholarship amount, depending on funds in the general scholarship account. The Sacklow fund document was edited and approved by the Board which allowed Ohav Shalom to support all students in a more generous way.

The Committee met and decided to individually consider the cost of each child's camp and the number of weeks he/she would attend in the summer of 2021. We were also committed to supporting our younger families with a base scholarship for day campers, plus a weekly stipend. Overnight campers were given more generous scholarships to reflect the higher cost of their camping experiences.

Twelve campers were awarded scholarships. Six overnight campers, attending from 2 to 4 weeks of camp, and six day-campers, attending 4 to 6 weeks of camp, were awarded scholarships this summer. We didn't have any applicants attending Israeli programs this summer.

Ohav Shalom awarded \$12,500 in summer camp scholarships last year: \$10,000 to overnight campers who attended Camps Ramah & Eden Village and \$ 2,500 to day campers who attended Camp Givah.

Applications for summer, 2022, are due by April 1, 2022, and several have already been received. Ohav Shalom Scholarships not only support day and overnight campers, but also students seeking to attend High School in Israel programs during Fall and Spring semesters. We are thankful for our blessings at having so many opportunities for supporting Jewish youth at Ohav.
