Morning services at 9:15 AM

## **SHABBAT, APRIL 4 (Day Three of Pesach/Chol Ha-Moed)**

Morning service at 9:15 AM

We chant Song of Songs at AM services.

Shabbat ends at 8:08 PM

## **SUNDAY APRIL 5 THROUGH TUESDAY, APRIL 7: CHOL HAMOED (PESACH INTERMEDIATE DAYS)**

End of Day 8 of Pesach and Day 2 of Yom Tov: 8:14 PM.

**Please remember to wait at least one hour after the holiday ends on April 9 before eating Chametz products in your home so that Rabbi Ornstein can buy back all Chametz sold on behalf of the community before Passover.**
